



Dear parents and children,

We sadly inform you that we have to stop the lessons at the premises of One Child-One world for as long as the Greek state requires.

If you agree, our goal is to continue to support your children with their schoolwork through the internet and/or phone.

Children that took part in the study group lessons (they did their homework with us) can continue to communicate with their teachers and send them questions regarding homework. Children can contact their teachers Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 2:00p.m. until 5:00pm. The teachers will reply until 7:00p.m. at the latest.

Please contact the teachers ONLY at the days and times given.

Here is a step by step guide you child should follow (with your help!)

1. Sit in a quiet space to start your homework. Make sure everything you need for studying is close to you.
2. Look at your exercises, read the instructions and examples carefully and try to understand what is asked of you.
3. If you understand the instructions fill in the blanks.
4. If you CANNOT understand what is needed, take a CLEAR picture of the page and send it to your teacher. (Younger children need your help to complete this step.)
5. Along with the picture send a voice message with your question.
6. Continue doing your homework and wait for your teacher to reply to your question.
7. When you finish your homework take CLEAR pictures of the exercises you have solved and send them to your teacher for checking.
8. Wait again for your teacher to contact you.
9. If you have made mistakes, try to correct them.
10. Be patient. Your teacher might take a while to reply to you because they have other students that also need help.

Please reply to this message by sending us the application of your choice (whatsapp, viber, messenger, skype), the phone number you would like the teacher to use and your username if needed.

Very soon you will receive a message on the application and number you have chosen from your child's teacher.

We will miss seeing you in person but we will all try to do our best under these difficult circumstances!
